La identificación

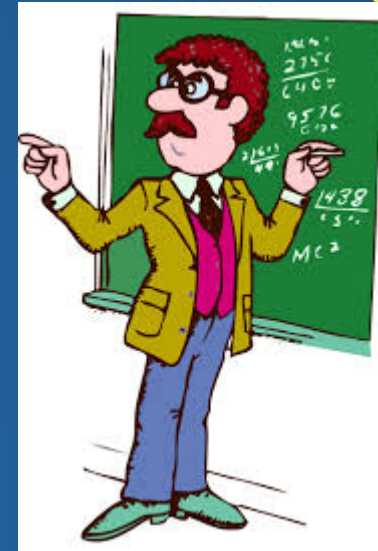
Where someone or thing is related or teaching.

The date and or time of an event.

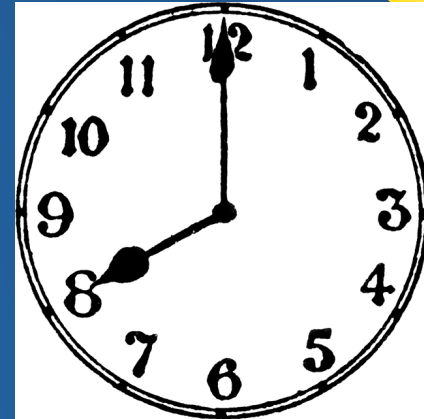


Hoy es el once de febrero.

Mañana es el veinte de marzo.

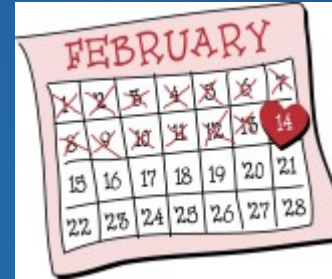
Mi hermano cumple años es enero de trece a dos.

Possession

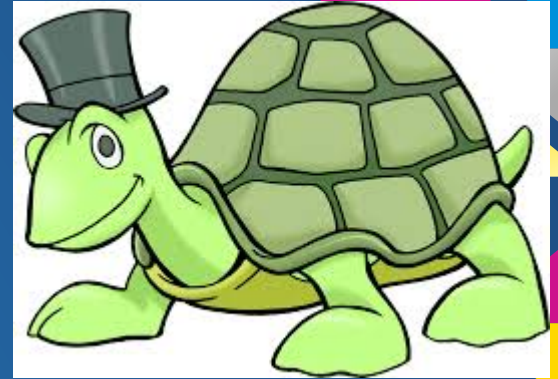
A thing that belongs to someone or something that belongs to someone.
