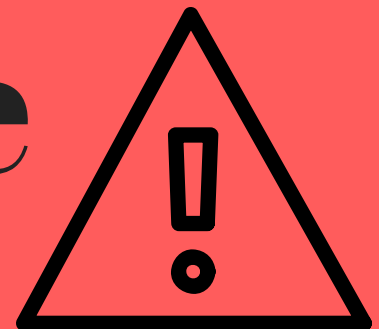


In schools, is

are 18 times more likely to get tried as adults than white students. 31% of those black students are subjected to in school arrests.
