WEALTH FACTS IN U.S

These are some facts about wealth in the U.S. that people need to know about. These facts affect everyone, so everyone should know about them.

1 WHO OWNS WHAT?

White families hold 90% of the national wealth. Hispanic families hold 2.3% of the national wealth. Black families hold 2.6% of the national wealth. The remaining 5.1% of the national wealth is held by others (natives, Asians, Pacific Islanders, multi-racial, etc.).

2 WHO HAS A JOB?

While the nation's official unemployment rate stands at 9.7 percent, it is nearly 16 percent among African Americans and 12.4 percent among Latinos.

3 HOW MUCH DO YOU GET?

For every dollar of wealth owned by the typical white family, the typical family of color owns only 16 cents.

WHAT ABOUT US?


The median wealth for single black women is only \$100; for single Hispanic women, \$120. This compares to just over \$41,000 for single white women. About a third of single Hispanic women and one-fourth of single black women have no checking or savings account.

BLACK AND HISPANIC FEMALES

The report found nearly half of all single black and Hispanic women have zero or negative wealth, meaning their debts exceed all their assets.



AVERAGE FAMILIES WEALTH Based on Race

The average white family has a net worth of \$679k. The average Hispanic family has a net worth of \$112k. The average black family has a net worth of \$95k.





BLACK PEOPLE LEARN LESS THAN WHITE PEOPLE REGARDLESS OF EDUCATION

White pupils always earn about \$4 more than their black peers for doing the same job.
