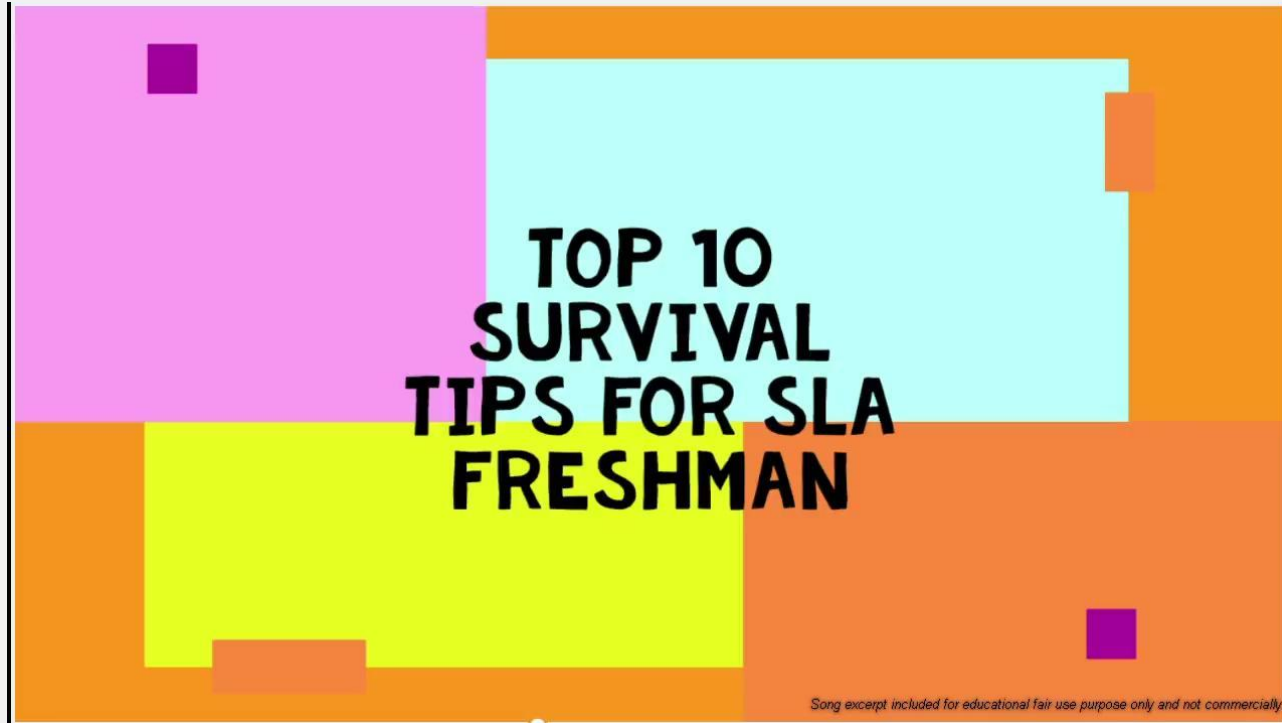
The Guiding Question

How My Idea Changed Over Time

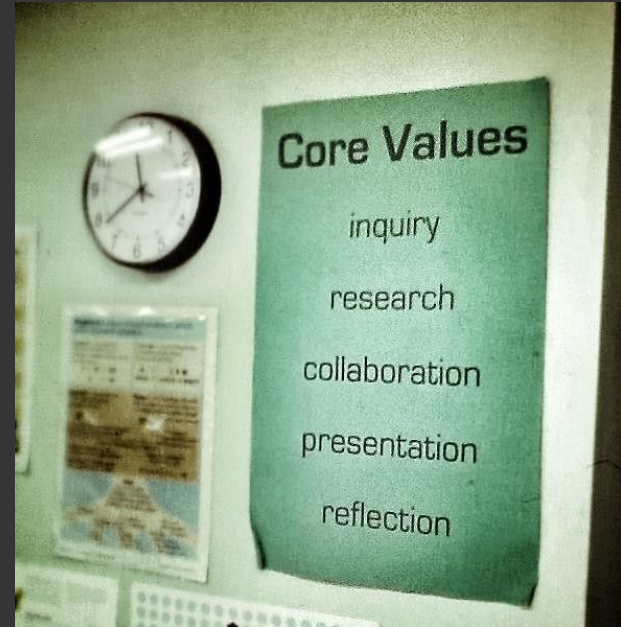
My first capstone idea wasn't the idea that I have now. Originally, I wanted to have it be related to the organization/group that I attended meetings with.
