

In Pennsylvania, firearms are responsible for 1,574 fatalities and 3,058 injuries annually. Pennsylvania state has the 27th highest gun violence in the U.S. Estimates show 321 people are shot on average every day in the United States. 111 of them pass away, including 65 suicides and 42 homicides, accidental shootings death, police shootings, one deaths for which there is no known reason. Many of these deaths stem from many incidents such as school shootings, drive-bys, gang violence and mistaken identity etc. Mass shootings, tragedies after tragedies, and ongoing social issues are all a result of gun violence in the United States. Due to this, gun violence has claimed numerous innocent lives.
