1983

The Domain Name System (DNS) establishes the familiar .edu, .gov, .com, .mil, .org, .net, and .int system for naming websites. This is easier to remember than the previous designation for websites, such as 123.456.789.10.

1989

World.std.com becomes the first commercial provider of dial-up access to the internet. Which could've inspired other commercial providers and it is the start of a commercial provider

1991

CERN introduces the World Wide Web to the public.

1995

Compuserve, America Online and Prodigy begin to provide internet access. Amazon.com, Craigslist and eBay go live. Which allows people to order stuff online, this improved society because people were able to order stuff even if they didn't have a store that sold the items they needed there
