Tsunamis are natural disasters that occur due to underwater disturbances which include: Earthquakes, Landslides, Volcanic eruptions.



The Pacific Ring of Fire and the Mediterranean-Asian Seismic Belt get Tsunamis often because of frequent volcanic and seismic events.

Matter is involved in Tsunamis as well because it begins with initial disturbance followed by water displacement, and it travels to coastal areas, and causes destruction & flooding.


